# FEBRUARY 2011 MINUTES

**The February 20, 2011, Mid-Missouri Corvette Club** meeting was called to order by President, Ronda Overfelt at D.Rowe's in Columbia with 27 in attendance.

**Vice President's Report:** Tommy Mallory gave the vice president's report due to Dallas' absence. Our March meeting will be Sunday, March 20, at the Quality Inn at 1:00 p.m. This is a bring your own brown bag lunch meeting.

**Secretary's Report:** Charlotte requested that a motion be made to accept the December 2010 and January 2011 meeting minutes as printed in the newsletters. Kathy Phillips made the motion and it was seconded by Larry Meyer. Motion passed.
